From the Secretary/Treasurer

The CSAA is holding steady financially. We had to move the bank account as the branch we had decided to close the only office it had in Colorado Springs and move it to Parker.

Another productive business meeting in November with some changes you need to be made aware of. We have changed the Master Senior and Senior divisions for tournaments. In the past they competed against all in the adult division and awards were given to the highest scoring Master Senior and Senior. Now the Master Seniors will compete against other Master Seniors in their own division. Seniors will compete against other Seniors in their division, not against all the adults. There is a “but” to this new rule, that is, Master Senior or Senior may be voluntary at individual archers discretion. In other words if an archer is old enough to shoot Master Senior or Senior but does not want to move out of the Adult division they do not have to, and they will receive all their overall points in the adult division. Trophies will now be given in Master Senior and Senior divisions. Records will also be kept for those setting or breaking them in the Master Senior and Senior divisions, this year the winners will all be setting new records.

Another change to make you aware of is regarding teams. We have had great participation of teams in most of the tournaments, the Target and Field are down compared to the indoors and mail-in’s but still participation has increased. This prompted us to now start keeping team records. As with the Master Senior and Senior divisions, this year all first place teams will be setting new records. So get your teams together!

We have a new officer joining the Executive Committee, that being Brian Bowers. Brian is now our Pro-Representative. I know Brian will do a good job. If any one has questions or comments regarding the Pro division I know Brian will be interested in hearing them.

Ken Buck Jr. has been working hard the past year on the website. He has added a new section under information titled CSAA News. This section is for any news happening in the CSAA community such as results from a club or shop tournament or just plain any news from clubs. I will be posting updates from time to time there as well. For anyone who has not been on the website in awhile I advise you to check it out and see what Ken has done.
